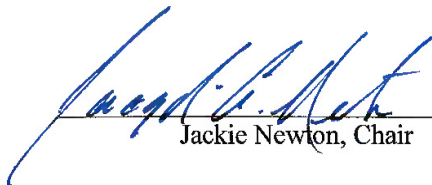

Resolution to Declare a Glock Model 22 Handgun Surplus and Award it to Retired Deputy Allen Dezso in Recognition of His Service to the Citizens of Pender County in the Pender County Sheriff's Office.

WHEREAS North Carolina General Statute § 20-187.2 states "...The governing body of a law enforcement agency may, in its discretion, also award to a retiring member or surviving relatives as provided herein, upon request, the service side arm of such deceased or retiring members, at a price determined by such governing body;" and
